


OUR PURPOSE






FARM TO TABLE

Chablé Maroma boasts four Ka'anche's, traditional Mayan gardens that allow us to recreate ancient harvesting techniques that have not been used in over a century. These gardens are home to a variety of aromatic herbs, including oregano, citronella, rosemary, thyme, rue, and mint. These herbs are sustainably cultivated and carefully harvested, and are then used in our spa to create unique and rejuvenating experiences for our guests.



WILDLIFE CONSERVATION

At Chablé Maroma, we are committed to preserving and protecting the natural environment and the diverse wildlife that calls it home. Our property is home to a wide range of wild species, including coatis, anteaters, raccoons, sereques, amphibians, and numerous species of birds, all of which roam freely in their natural habitats.

We do not believe in keeping animals in captivity, and instead strive to provide a safe and healthy environment for all of the wildlife that shares our land. By respecting and preserving the natural ecosystem, we are able to offer our guests a truly authentic and immersive experience in the heart of the Mayan jungle.



SEA TURTLE PROGRAM

We are dedicated to protecting and conserving the turtle nests that inhabit our beach. We understand the importance of these incredible creatures and the crucial role they play in maintaining the balance of our ecosystem.

Our team of experienced professionals works tirelessly to ensure that the turtle nests are protected and that the hatchlings have the best possible chance of survival. By taking an active role in turtle conservation, we are proud to be contributing to the preservation of these incredible creatures for generations to come.

During 2022 a nest was protected, which hatched 88 eggs out of 102 eggs. Guests were invited to release sea turtles, following the guidelines to protect them (do not use flash or touch them and leave space for them to walk)



GREEN DAY PROGRAM

We are committed to promoting environmental awareness and care through our Green Day monthly program. This program includes a variety of activities that engage our leaders and collaborators, promote interdepartmental integration, and encompass the four pillars of our Wellness Spirit.

Some of these activities include beach and dunes conservation and cleaning, well-being programs for our employees, and initiatives aimed at reducing our environmental impact.

Each year, we recognize the employee who has made the greatest contribution to our Green Day program, underscoring our commitment to sustainability and community engagement.

WASTE MANAGEMENT



We are committed to reducing our environmental impact by minimizing waste generation and promoting recycling and composting. To achieve this, we have implemented various measures, such as offering straws only upon request and using avocado-based, single-use products that are delivered in Kraft bags.

We also reuse the ashes from our temazcal and bonfires in gardening and composting, which includes citrus peels, ash, and occasional shredding of palm fronds. In 2022 alone, we generated 1 and a half tons of compost since we started the initiative in August.

Additionally, we donate excess items to registered Civil Associations. We are committed to continuously finding ways to minimize our waste and promote a sustainable future for our planet.





WATER WASTE

In 2022, Chablé Maroma implemented a water consumption meter in the laundry area to monitor and manage our water use.

To reduce our reliance on single-use plastic bottles, we provided guests with access to water fillers, which were used 7,586 times, resulting in a total of 7,586 500ml bottles with 3,793 liters of water. Our internal water filtration system uses a double filtration process and UV light to ensure the water is safe for consumption.

We also have a wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) where the water produced is used to irrigate all the green areas of the hotel.



EDUCATION FOR SUSTAINABILITY

At Chablé Maroma, we believe that education is key to promoting sustainability. We provide regular awareness talks for our collaborators, to ensure that everyone is informed and engaged in our efforts to reduce our environmental impact. We also collaborate with external organizations to provide educational talks and workshops to our team members, to keep them informed about the latest sustainability issues and solutions.

CLEAN ENERGY

On December 2022, we installed 734 solar panels, to reduce approximately 20% of our energy consumption.



CORAL REEF PRESERVATION

Starting in December 2022, Chablé Maroma launched a coral program in partnership with the Mexican NGO Oceanus A.C. Our staff received training on coral conservation, and we organized family trips and awareness-raising activities for guests during festivals.

Our goal is to contribute to the growth of 600 coral colonies within the next year, in line with our commitment to protecting and preserving the marine ecosystem.



SUSTAINABLE EXPERIENCES FOR OUR GUESTS

We offer a variety of sustainable experiences and activities for our guests to enjoy. Our activities include Rowing with a Cause, where guests can take part in an environmentally friendly rowing excursion and support an NGO. We also offer workshops with local artisans to learn about traditional Mexican crafts and techniques. For those interested in recycling, we have Recycled Paper Activities where guests can learn how to make paper out of recycled materials. Additionally, guests can participate in Adopting a Coral, a program in partnership with Oceanus A.C., where they can help preserve and restore coral reefs.


Other activities include Beach Yoga, Painting Coconut, Making Compost at Home, and Planting Aromatic Herbs and Palm Trees. We also offer various workshops for children, providing them with opportunities to learn about sustainability and the importance of protecting our planet.



BEACH AND DUNES

We have 180 m long of beach, which is not only a place for relaxation and recreation, but also a space where we can connect with nature and learn about the importance of its conservation. We also promote the preservation of the dunes by implementing cleaning activities, removing any trash or debris that could negatively impact the ecosystem.

In addition, we encourage our guests to participate in beach conservation and cleaning activities, where they can learn about the importance of preserving our natural resources and how they can contribute to this effort.



VEGETATION AND MANGROVE PRESERVATION

At Chablé Maroma, we understand the importance of preserving the natural beauty and ecological balance of our surrounding environment. As such, we have taken a variety of measures to ensure the protection of our vegetation and mangroves.



Our sustainable approach to construction and design includes the use of local materials, such as zapote and chaca tree trunks, to minimize our impact on the terrain. Additionally, we have implemented permanent flood level monitoring stations to maintain the best conditions for mangrove conservation. We are proud to have preserved beach vegetation and the ground water table of the region, allowing our guests to experience the beauty of the natural environment while minimizing our impact on it.

Chablé Maroma's boutique showcases a variety of unique and authentic Mexican products from different states, providing guests with the opportunity to take a piece of Mexico home with them while supporting local commerce. This may quite possibly be the only hotel anywhere in Mexico that provides the level of wellness travellers now hop on planes for with the country's trademark sugary beaches. It is a worthy second act from the brand whose resort Chablé, in the jungles of the Yucatán, made waves in the wellness world with its intelligent, stylish approach to holistic health nearly three years ago (that cenote! That spa!). The focus hasn't shifted at Maroma, but this place does feel remarkably more resort-like than its boutique sibling. With 70 neutral-palette suites, it's nearly twice as large, and each has its own pool, terrace and palm-shrouded outdoor rain shower. And let's not forget its access to Riviera Maya's powdery sands (we definitely missed the surf at Chablé). True to the brand, Maroma's bright spa remains deeply rooted in Mayan healing traditions (the temazcal ceremony, led by a local healer, is the real deal, requiring a two-hour commitment). While your schedule in the Yucatán is packed with fitness classes and spa sessions, Maroma encourages time spent sipping margaritas by the infinity pool, as any Mexican hotel should. Chef Jorge Vallejo of Mexico City's top-ranked Quintonil oversees the menus at both outposts, sourcing ingredients from on-site ka'anches (Mayan gardens). Naturally, seafood is the star at Maroma, showcased
